**SUBJECT:** **PCAHA Juvenile Scholarship Tournament (2014-2015).**

The 33rd annual Pacific Coast Amateur Hockey Association **Juvenile Scholarship Tournament** will be held from January 26-31, 2015.

This special recognition event is held annually by the PCAHA to showcase the talents of players in the Juvenile Division, especially those who exhibit the qualities of good sportsmanship, leadership, character, and playing ability. In addition, the Tournament aims to promote participation in Minor Hockey at the Juvenile level and to increase participation by Juvenile players in the PCAHA Scholarship Program.

For purposes of the Tournament, the Juvenile "A" teams within the PCAHA have been divided into three groups. One Tournament team will be drawn from each group.

To be eligible for selection to one of the Tournament teams, a player must be registered with a Juvenile team within the PCAHA. First preference is given to graduating Juveniles (20 year old as of December 31st). Any player having incurred a Gross Misconduct or Match Penalty during the current season or who has accumulated excessive penalty minutes was not eligible for selection. The Juvenile division Coaches and Managers in each Association were asked to nominate players who meet the criteria by December 22, 2014. Some Juvenile teams may not be represented because of a lack of eligible 20 year old players.

Team officials for the Tournament will be selected by the Juvenile Managing Director and Special Events Committee on the basis of recommendations received, past coaching record, and philosophy of the game. The team officials are listed on the attached page.

At the conclusion of the tournament, a Juvenile Special Bursary Award worth \$500.00 will be awarded to the player on each Tournament team adjudged to have best exemplified excellence and sportsmanship during the course of the Tournament. These Bursaries must be applied by the recipients towards post-secondary study according to the guidelines of the PCAHA Scholarship Program.

I would like to take the opportunity to thank the Tournament host Associations: **Coquitlam MHA** (Brian Keenan, President), **Ridge Meadows MHA** (Scott Falconer, President), **Port Coquitlam MHA** (Kim Egli, President) and **North Delta MHA** (Anita Cairney, President) for their support of this event.
