According to BC Hockey's rotation of host Districts, the Lower Mainland District is scheduled to host the following BC Hockey Championships during Spring Break, 2024:

U15 Tier 1

• U13 Tier 3

In accordance with BC Hockey Regulation 7, the PCAHA is requesting applications to host these BC Hockey Championships. If your Association is interested in hosting, please submit a letter of request to me by not later than **May 15, 2023**. If multiple bids to host are received, a decision of the District will be made at the PCAHA Annual General Meeting on May 28th.

Other championships may become available if the designated District is unable to host. However, it will likely not be known until the BC Hockey Annual General Meeting in June which other championships are available. BC Hockey normally advertises for hosts for any vacant playoffs.

FORMAT:	 If 7 or fewer teams - single round-robin with championship game (1st vs. 2nd): 5 teams - 11 games over 3 days 6 teams - 16 games over 4 days 7 teams - 22 games over 5 days If 8 or more teams - teams are split into two round-robin groups (single round-robin in each) with cross-over semi-finals and championship/3rd place games 8 teams - 16 games over 4 days 9 teams - 20 games over 4 days 10 teams - 24 games over 5 days 11 teams - 29 games over 6 days
GAMES:	 Three (3) 20-minute stop-time periods Ice cleans between periods Overtime only in championship games
